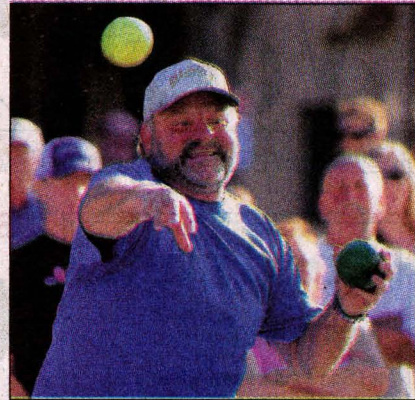


## GETTING DUNKED DOWNTOWN
