Message from the "Prez" - "Slatts"

Welcome to November's INCOMING. As always we've been busy with activities of a Welcome Home, the veteran swim challenge from Alcatraz, Veteran's Day Parade in Pleasanton & continued planning meetings for our *Holiday Dinner & Charity Crab Feed*.

Our October dinner speaker at Crow Canyon Country Club was our own *Contra Costa County Veteran Service Officer* (CCC VSO), Nathan Johnson. Nathan shared with us more of the detailed benefits that we as veterans have earned. The bottom line is this... if you have not been to the VSO office in Martinez, you need to do so. It is painless & who knows? You might learn something that will benefit you & your family.

I mentioned at the August dinner meeting, we were sponsoring a "veteran swim challenge" in the bay from Alcatraz to the San Francisco Aquatic Park area. This event took place on Saturday Oct 12 even though the Federal government was in a budget shut-down. I only state that because there were issues that may have impacted the swim (e.g., the beach at Aquatic park (the get out of the water spot) is a federal park and was "closed/off limits". A last minute meeting determined a work-around/let's just do it. We provided a high carbo breakfast for them before they sailed out to Alcatraz to swim back to SF. Then while they were swimming, our BBQ'ers made lunch for all the participants and their families. Another big glitch was when the government boat ride informed us they would not be able to carry the swimmer to Alcatraz to swim back. However, our member Bob Musor stepped in with a large sailboat and he recruited friends who had sailboats and they were able to get the swimmers to Alcatraz for the swim. *A big thanks to Bob, his friends and all who assisted in this effort.* This was a huge success for the veterans as they accomplished a swim challenge that few people have attempted and successfully accomplished. *Congratulations to all!*

Veterans Day (Nov 11th at 11 am – remember 11/11@11) planning is complete and is ready to be held again at San Ramon Valley High School Performance Theater in Danville (it's the building where we form up for the 4th of July parade each year). This is a joint VSO effort (VFW, MCL, AL & BSM along with us), not just VNVDV members. Along with that program, the Veterans Memorial Building will be open on Sat & Sun (11/9 & 11/10) from 9 am to 3 pm and again Monday noon to 3 pm with special displays of educational & historic military items, including uniforms - military vehicles - radios to operate along with many other displays provided by the veteran service organizations. The Blue Star Moms will have a Post Card Table to send notes to the troops & more. Designed for the family to keep history alive through education. We also had our VNVDV Parade Truck - JR's 49 International Harvester with our banners. VP Ray LaRochelle coordinated the military service colors as he will for our Veteran's Day program on Monday - Nov. 11th in Danville. Thanks to all members who volunteer to help in this very worthwhile effort.

Our December Holiday Dinner Meeting will be on Thursday Dec 5th. This will be a sit-down & served dinner. The entrée choices will be Prime Rib or Salmon. This is RSVP - so please contact VP Ray LaRochelle with your reservation number and choice of entrées. This information will be needed before Thanksgiving. At this special dinner meeting we will be recognizing & showing our appreciation to those who contributed their time and efforts this past year.

The ballot we had last month for by-law changes was passed by a majority of all votes cast. The Board will take the appropriate action by informing the State of California of our updated by-laws.

The SRV Veterans Memorial Building is open from 9 am to 3 pm each day, Monday – Friday. There are a number of docents that stand 3 hr shifts to share the building information & displays with visitors. We are looking for more volunteers (easy 1 hour training provided), so if you are interested in volunteering 1 or 2 shifts a month (not much time taken away from your schedule) please let me know.

We have started to plan the Super Sunday Crab Feed/ Fund Raiser. This coming year it will be held on Sunday Feb 2, 2014 - our 10th year! This needs a number of hands to assist in various positions. None of them are hard, but since this is a big fund raiser (we usually raise approximately \$8000 - \$9000 for our organization) we've got quite a few sub-committees to break up the work load. If you are interested in helping please see me. Donations are needed.

Remember the various veteran groups who use the SRV Veteran Memorial Building (we being one of them) are having "Saturday morning coffee" gatherings. It's open from 8 – 11 am each Saturday. It's a nice way to spend an occasional Saturday morning visiting with fellow veterans. Come when you'd like between 8 & 11 & leave when you'd like. It's just a nice way to start a Saturday morning.

According to our by-laws a "life membership" dues in the VNVDV is calculated as 8 times the annual dues. Since our dues were lowered this year to \$25 per year, the life membership payment of \$200 is a bargain for you to consider. If you are considering this, please contact Membership Chairman Bill Chew.

Finally, don't forget our Welcome Home's. As mentioned each month, if you are interested in participating in these, let John Reese know you want to be on the distribution when we learn about when these young warriors come home. No special skills are needed, just show up with a flag in your hand, a smile on your face and a thank you hand shake for the young man or woman. These are fun gatherings and only take about an hour out of your day. It is very fulfilling for both the returnees and to each of us. We had a dual welcome home mid-October with 2 military personnel at the same time.





Each year many businesses recognize those who proudly served our nation. The following list is not complete and can vary by location / area - please inquire about the special offers prior. The following restaurants give veterans and active duty military personnel a free meal or a free food item on or about Veterans Day. Just show your military ID, current LES (Leave and Earnings statement), DD214, or VA Health Care Photo ID Card. Offers vary – check your internet and local websites for more local discounts/deals.

1 **Applebee's** - Stop into a participating Applebee's on Monday, November 11, 2013 to get your Veterans day free meal. Choose a meal from a limited menu that includes steak, cheeseburgers, chicken tenders, salad, pasta, chicken, and shrimp. This deal is dine-in only and beverages and gratuity are not included.

2 **Chili's** - Free Meal on Veteran's Day - Nov. 11, 2013 from selected menu - including: Margarita Grilled Chicken, Chicken Club Tacos, Santa Fe Wrap, Old-time w/Cheese, Cobb Salad, and more. Beverages and gratuity not included.

From November 9-11, 2013, veterans are admitted free to more than 100 national parks across the United States - Fees waived.

2 **Home Depot** - Active duty military; reserve; retired military; and disabled veterans and family members get 10% off purchases up to \$500. Other veterans get 10% off on Memorial Day, July 4th, and on Veterans Day.

3 **Lowe's** - Active duty military; National Guard and Reserve; retired military; and disabled veterans and immediate family members get 10% off purchases in-stock and special orders up to \$5000. Other veterans get 10% off on Memorial Day, July 4th, and on Veterans Day. Note - for proof of veteran status—Show you VA Health Care Photo ID Card or military ID (active or retired).

Tips Before Heading Out for Free or Discount Offers:

- Review the official site information and rules before heading out. Check dates carefully on the internet and specific business sites. Many websites are listing previous years (2012) promotions that are no longer valid. We encourage you to link to the official information.
- Be sure to bring proof of military service, uniform photo or be in uniform. Proof of military service varies by company. See the list of states now offering a [Veterans designation](#) on a driver's license. VA Health Care System "photo ID" is usually acceptable or military ID (retired or active).
- Pay attention to the dates on the Veterans Day offer as some offers are for Sunday November 10th or extended over several days.
- Many of the restaurant free meals are for dine in only.
- Many of these promotions include small print that says participating locations only. Unfortunately individual franchisees may choose not to participate. Fortunately, some franchisee's participate even if the corporate company does not.
- Call ahead if you're unsure about anything. *Check on the internet for additional / new Veteran's Day offers not posted until the week prior.*



By-Law Modifications Approved at OCT 2013 Meeting - Submitted to CA Secretary of State

3.02.2 – Non Member

Former By-Law (last sentence): Persons who have been accorded Honorary status, are not members – do not pay dues – may not hold office - vote or inure any of the benefits of membership.

Approved By-Law correction (typo): ...may not hold office - vote or **incur** any of the benefits of membership.

3.04.B Privileges of Membership

Former By-Law: War veteran members in good standing, who are eligible for the Viet Nam Service Medal, may in addition, hold office or serve on the Board of Directors.

Approved By-Law correction 3.04.B: War veteran members in good standing, who are eligible for the Viet Nam Service Medal, may in addition, hold office or serve on the Board of Directors. **Board of Director positions other than officers may be held by war veteran members in good standing of the VNVDV.**

(Note: definition of officers vs. Board of Directors is 6.01 – officers are President, VP, Secretary & Treasurer. This change would allow VNVDV war veteran members who are not eligible for the Viet Nam Service Medal to be eligible for Board of Director positions)

Former By-Law: 10.05.A – Expenditure authorization

All checks issued by the organization in excess of five-hundred dollars (\$500.00) shall require two signatures. Only the Treasurer – President – Vice President and Secretary are authorized to sign the Organization's checks.

Approved By-Law correction : Only the Treasurer – President – Vice President and Secretary are authorized to sign the Organization's checks.

Former By-Law: 3.03.4 Life Applications

Any member who has been a member in good standing for a period of five (5) consecutive years or longer and who has held a position on the Board of Directors, served as the Chairperson or Co-chairperson of a VNVDV committee, or in some other way distinguished themselves as a member of the organization, may apply to the Board of Directors for Life Membership. Fee for Life membership shall be a one time sum equal to eight (8) times the annual dues at the time of the conversion.

Approved By-Law correction: Fee for Life membership shall be a one time sum equal to eight (8) times the annual dues at the time of the conversion






