Captain Randell J. Ramian, USN

On our Thursday... January 2nd Dinner meeting, we will spend an hour with Captain Ramian who provide an overview history of the USS Hornet (CV-8).

We are all familiar with the USS Hornet (CV-12) and the connection with Apollo 11 and the first moon landing, but did you know it was originally named the USS Dearsarge? The name was changed in honor of the USS Hornet (CV-8) that was sunk at the Battle of the Santa Cruz Islands in 1942. Our beloved Hornet, now a floating museum and anchored in Alameda, is in fact, the eighth USS Hornet. The first was a ten-gun sloop commissioned in 1775 and served in the American Revolutionary War. The first two ships in the Continental Navy were the Hornet and the Wasp.


*Come join us for our January dinner meeting to meet & hear **Captain Randall J. Ramian, USN, CEO of the USS Hornet Museum**, who will be educating us on the 240 year history of the Hornet ships. The Doolittle Raid, Battle of Midway, Battle of Santa Cruz Island, First Barbary War, Spanish-American War and yes, even the Viet Nam War are only a few of the conflicts the various Hornet ships have been involved in.*

The current Hornet (CV-12) is one of the most decorated ships of the US Navy. It destroyed over 1400 Japanese aircraft, ranking second behind the Essex. She shot down 72 enemy aircraft in a single day, in which 10 Hornet pilots attained "Ace in a Day" status.

The Hornet is now a floating museum. She educates and also entertains us. She hosts big bands, school groups and girl scout overnights. And one more thing, the USS Hornet is said to be one of the most haunted places in America.



EBSD 2014 is scheduled for September 11 to 14, 2014. The first public informational / coordination planning meeting will be held, January 14, 2014, at the Veterans Memorial Building - 115 E. Prospect Avenue in Danville - beginning at 6:30 PM (1830).

MARINE DAY LUNCHEON -- 9 JANUARY 2014

The United States Marine Corps Council of Northern California is proud to announce the Marine Day Luncheon on Thursday, 9 Jan 2014, from 11:45 A.M. to 14:30 in the Crystal Ballroom at the Marines' Memorial Club and Hotel, 609 Sutter St., San Francisco.

The guest speaker will be Major General Lawrence D. Nicholson, Commanding General, 1st Marine Division. Prior to assuming Command of 1MARDIV, Major General Nicholson commanded the 5th Marine Regiment and deployed with them to Fallujah, Iraq. Major General Nicholson served as the Deputy Commanding General, Marine Corps Combat Development Command at Quantico and in January of 2009 became the Commanding General of the 2nd Marine Expeditionary Brigade, Task Force Leatherneck, and deployed with them for a year to Southern Afghanistan. Upon return from this combat tour he was assigned as the Senior Military Assistant to the Deputy Secretary of Defense in Washington DC in July 2010 and in February 2012, Major General Nicholson returned to Afghanistan for a year serving as the Operations Officer for the ISFA Joint command in Kabul, Afghanistan. Major General Nicholson assumed command of the 1st Marine Division in June 2013.

Coordination Council President Colonel Allan Cruz, USMC (Ret.) will present the *Marine of the Year Award* at the luncheon.

An excellent buffet luncheon will be served prior to the Major General's presentation. This event is open to all active duty, retired and veteran Marines, as well as friends of marines. The USMC Coordinating Council encourages all Bay Area Marines and Veteran marines to attend and bring a guest.


